Travel information

If you travel <u>by car</u>, you can direct to the hotel's private underground car park. From Brussels: E40 motorway in the direction of Ostend, exit n° 9 (Oostkamp), at the end of the exit take the direction of "Brugge 7km", after 4-5 km cross the bridge over the

canal, continue straight down the avenue called "Baron Ruzettelaan", at the end of the "Baron Ruzettelaan" you will arrive at the Bruges ring road, cross it, drive across the bridge and enter the "Katelijnestraat".

Continue down the "Katelijnestraat", pass the red-brick church "Onze-Lieve-Vrouwekerk" on your right, after the church, take the "Mariastraat" on your left, and continue along the "Oude Burg" on the right, at the end of the "Oude Burg ", pass in front of the hotel just behind the Belfry. To gain access to the hotel car park: at the end of the "Oude Burg-straat", opposite a florist, take the "Wollestraat" on your right, after 30 m, turn right into the small "Kartuizerinnestraat", the entry to the car park is just around the corner.

Participants <u>by air-plane</u> may arrive at Ostend or Brussels National Airport. From Brussels National Airport you can take a shuttle to Brussels and then travel further on by train. From Ostend, you can take a train directly to Bruges.

Participants that come <u>by train.</u> From Brussels (North, Central or South) take the train to "Blankenberge/Knokke" or to "Ostend". Both trains stop at the station in Bruges. There are trains each ½ hour. Time-tables for the trains can be found at <u>www.b-rail.be</u>

From the station in Bruges, you can walk to the Hotel (about 20 minutes). Walk to "'t Zand", take the "Steenstraat" and you will arrive at the "Markt". You can also take a bus to the "Markt". The Oude Burg and the Hotel are situated at the back of the Belfry.
