

## How to Use the Programme and Abstract Books

Apart from the Plenaries, the sessions in the Congress have been organised in 13 themes: Biological Understanding, Mental Health and Behavioural Development, Cognition and Communication, Physical Health and Profound Multiple Disabilities, Families, Education and Work, Community Living, Lifespan and Ageing, Quality of Life, Individual in Society, Populations and Service Systems, Environment, and Science and Research Methodology.


There are 20 parallel sessions for oral presentations (and a 21st for posters) from Tuesday onwards. Simultaneous French/English translation is available in five of the oral presentation parallel sessions (in Sully 1, Sully 2, Sully 3, Rondelet, Barthez). All presenters who come from French-speaking countries have been allocated to these sessions, together with a representative sample of other symposia or roundtables from all of the themes. In both the 5 rooms with translation and the 15 without, sessions on the same theme follow on from each other in the same room throughout the Congress as much as possible.

The schedule of sessions across the six days of the Congress is set out in the ***Programme Book*** on pages 9-27. The Programme Book also contains two indexes, listing the moderators and presenters for all of the sessions. Using these can tell you who is doing what in which session.

The ***Abstract Book*** is a double issue of the *Journal of Intellectual Disability Research*. It contains 14 sections, relating to the plenary presentations and 13 themes. The plenary presentation abstracts come first and the themed sections follow in the order in which they are listed above. In each themed section, the abstracts for two oral paper symposia or roundtables are generally set out on one page under the symposia or roundtable titles (unless there are both French and English versions of the abstracts, where there will usually be only one per page). Abstracts for oral sessions are then followed by the poster abstracts for that theme arranged in alphabetical order by the first author's name.


The schedule (pp. 9-27) in this ***Programme Book*** gives the following information:

### Mode d'emploi du programme et du livre des résumés

Les séances plénieries mises à part les sessions du congrès sont organisées autour de 13 thèmes: biologie, santé mentale et développement du comportement, cognition et communication, santé physique, polyhandicap, les familles, l'éducation et le travail, la vie en société, vieillissement, qualité de vie, la personne dans la société, les populations et les services, l'environnement, la méthodologie en science et en recherche.


Il y a 20 sessions de présentation orale (21 si l'on compte les posters) à partir de mardi. Une traduction simultanée Français/Anglais est disponible pour 5 sessions (dans les salles Sully 1, Sully 2, Sully 3, Rondelet et Barthez). Tous les intervenants venant des pays francophones ont été répartis dans ces cinq salles. Un thème particulier et spécifique à chaque salle y sera traité. Eventuellement d'autres thèmes pourront y être abordés. Dans les 15 autres salles de sessions parallèles un seul et même thème est présenté par salle et ce en grand partie pendant la durée du congrès.

Le planning des sessions pendant les 6 jours du congrès se trouve dans le **Programme** (pp. 9-27) Ce livret contient 2 index: une liste des modérateurs et une liste des intervenants. A l'aide de ces index vous pouvez savoir qui fait quoi et dans quelle session.

Le **Livre des Résumés** est constitué de deux numéros du *Journal of Intellectual Disability Research*. Il contient 14 sections en rapport avec les séances plénieries et les 13 thèmes. Le journal s'ouvre sur les résumés des séances plénieries et les sessions par thèmes dans l'ordre énoncé ci dessus. Dans chaque section à thème les résumés des 2 symposia ou tables rondes sont généralement présentés sur une même page sous le titre du symposia ou de la table ronde (sauf s'il existe des versions françaises et anglaises des résumés auquel cas il n'y a en aura le plus souvent qu'un par page). Les résumés des sessions orales sont suivis des résumés des posters, traitant le même thème, classé par ordre alphabétique du nom du premier auteur.
